

## Price: Bungalow 2024

### March to June/September:

The price per week for a NAV member is 400 euros and for a Novartis employee without membership is 500 euros including additional and cleaning costs.

### July to August:

The price per week is 500 euros for NAV members and 600 euros for Novartis employees without membership, including additional and cleaning costs.

In addition, there is a municipal tax of two euros per day per person, but this is only payable by people over 14 years of age. Please note that this amount is payable locally in Torrazza upon departure.

## Conditions

The minimum rental period is 1 week and rental takes place from Saturday to Saturday. The accommodation is suitable for 2 to a maximum of 4 people, ideal for 2 adults and 2 small children.

Check-in is from 4:00 p.m. and check-out is until 10:00 a.m.

The bungalow in Torrazza can accommodate a maximum of 4 adults. It has a bedroom with a double bed and a sofa bed in the living room. Ideal for 2 adults and 2 small children. The bungalow is equipped with electric heating and bed linen, towels, dishes and tea towels are provided. There is a TV in the living room and internet is available. The extendable table in the living room offers space for 4 people. In the kitchen you will find a Moka espresso pot, an oven and a dishwasher. On the terrace/loggia there is a table, two chairs, a deck chair and a clothes horse at your disposal. In the bathroom you will find a hairdryer including an adapter and a washing machine with towels. In the bedroom there is a double bed and a closet.

## Liability

We would like to point out that your booking creates a binding obligation to bear the costs incurred even in the event of non-use and please note that NAV declines any liability for damage caused by the guest. The member is personally liable and should take out appropriate insurance for damage to third parties. Any damage must be paid directly on site.

## Arrival and shopping options

Getting to Torrazza can be done by car by driving from Genoa via Imperia to Torrazza. Alternatively, you can take the train from Basel to Milan and then on to Imperia. From Imperia you can get to Torrazza by bus. Car rental is available in Imperia.

For shopping, we recommend that you get your essentials from the supermarket in Imperia. However, there is also a village shop in Torrazza, which is open daily and can cover your daily needs, such as fresh bread rolls and cheese.

## Emergencies

Various facilities are available for emergencies. There is a car repair shop in Imperia, a pharmacy in Molini or Doledo and a doctor/hospital in Imperia.
